

HISTORICAL NOTES <p><i>The original owner of Rosevale was Mr Henry Guy who probably did not live there. The homestead itself was constructed by George King whilst still under the ownership of Henry Guy. It was gradually extended over the following years increasing rooms and adding verandahs and eventually enclosing the verandahs. It is located within the Village of Kayuga. In 1918 the Lonergan family purchased the property, which received power in 1941 and was connected to the sewer in 1985. The Lonergans are still in ownership, although the late Vince Lonergan died in April 1993.</i></p>
