


<b>HISTORICAL NOTES</b> <p><i>This house is of local interest for its association with the St Vincent de Paul building to the left and the Eatons Hotel to the right. It is a single storeyed brick house with wide eaved rough cast bracketted gable to street verandah with paired timber posts on scalloped and rough cast balustrade wall and supporting tiled modern roof. There are French doors to either side of the modern central door.</i></p>

<b>STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE</b> <p><i>Historically the building has local significance for having been able to be built between earlier commercial buildings in the main centre of Muswellbrook. It is unusual in this respect and indicates a period in which residential and commercial uses were intermixed. Aesthetically it is representative of type at a regional level. Scientifically the building is of local significance for its potential to reveal information that could contribute to an understanding of the development of the commercial heart of Bridge Street in the early 20th century.</i></p>
