


STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p><i>Historically the building plays an important local role in the development of Bridge Street in the early 20th century. It is unique and rare in Bridge Street for having been relocated to the site, the centre of Bridge Street activity at the time, to meet this demand. Although the building is visually unusual in its "new" context, it is representative of type regionally. Scientifically the building is rare of type in its context for its potential to reveal information which could contribute to an understanding of the rate of growth of early 20th century Muswellbrook retailing as well as to the geographical origins of the building.</i></p>
