




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<b>HISTORICAL NOTES</b> <p>The later 19th and early 20th century subdivision and development is represented by a number of houses and small houses in the Lake Liddell area. Individually they are not all of outstanding heritage significance, however, considered as a group, they provide clear evidence of the later development and use of the area. Hillcrest is an early 20th century weatherboard cottage with numerous outbuildings. It is quite significant in its demonstration of architectural development during the early part of the century and the effect of subdivision on the area and late economic uses. Hillcrest is an example of less wealthy subdivisions of this period.</p>

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<b>STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE</b> <p>Like "Fairview" (Item Lidd/R002), Hillcrest has local historic significance for its association with later 19th century and early 20th century land subdivision in the Lake Liddell area. Its greatest significance must be its aesthetic significance which derives from its being a rare regional example of Federation Bungalow executed in timber. It has local scientific significance for its potential to reveal information which could contribute to an understanding of the economic means and lifestyles of the earliest farmers of the land in this area.</p>
