Site Plan

Your Site Plan must show:

- Street name and number
- Buildings on the property
- Location on water supply meter(s)
- Details and locations of all processes, tanks, pits, and apparatus associated with the generation of liquid trade waste
- Details, locations, capacity/dimensions of the proposed pre-treatment facilities
- Details of pipes and floor drainage conveying the affluent
- Stormwater Drainage Plan

The following are prohibited from being discharged into the sewerage system:

- Organochlorine weedicides, fungicides, pesticides, herbicides and substances of a similar nature and/or wastes arising from the preparation of these substances
- Organophosphorus pesticides and/or waste arising from the preparation of these substances

- Any substances liable to produce noxious or poisonous vapours in the sewerage system
- Organic solvents and mineral oil
- Any flammable or explosive substances
- Discharges from "Bulk Fuel Depots"
- Chromate from cooling towers
- Natural or synthetic resins, plastic monomers, synthetic adhesives, rubber and plastic emulsions

- Rain, surface, seepage or subsoil water, unless specifically permitted
- Solid matter
- Any substance assessed as not suitable to be discharged to the sewerage system
- Waste liquids that contain pollutants at concentrations which inhibit the sewage treatment process – refer Guidelines for Sewerage Systems: Acceptance of Trade Waste (Industrial Waste) (ARMCANZ/ ANZECC, 1994).
