# rethink

A lot of the water consumed by a household can be saved. Here are some key things that you can do to save water in your home:

#### **SHOWERS**

A standard shower head uses about 15 -25 litres of water per minute. A 4 star rated shower head uses as little as 6-7 litres per minute. Using a 4 star rated shower head for an 8 minute shower will save 48 litres of water.

# **TAPS**

Standard taps use 15 – 18 litres per minute, whilst low flow and aerating models use as little as 2 litres per minute.

A dripping tap can waste up to 30 – 200 litres / day.

# **WASHING MACHINES**

A water efficient 4 star rated washing machine uses 1/3 of the water of an older model. This can save up to 50 litres of water per load. 15 - 20% of all water used in the home is used in the laundry.

#### **DISHWASHERS**

The most efficient dishwashers use half the water of an average model. This can save you approximately 10 litres of water per load.

#### **TOILETS**

An old single flush toilet can use up to 12 litres per flush, whereas dual flush toilets use less than 4 litres per flush on average. This saves a bucket of water each time you flush. Using a water efficient dual flush toilet reduces household water use by around 30,000-40,000 litres every year. Ensure your cistern isn't leaking – put a couple of drops of food dye in your cistern, if the water in the toilet bowl changes colour before you flush, your cistern is leaking and wasting water.
