


The hotel has great local historical	al significance, being representative of m	nainstreet commercial de	evelopment	in Muswellbrook from before the
advent of the railway. Aesthetically the building retains the integrity of the one hundred and thirty year old structure while accomodating the				
significant extensions of the Fede	eration period. In this it is unique in the re	egion and thus has regir	onal signific	ance. Socially the hotel has local

significance for its identification with the social life of Muswellbrook centre for more than a century. Scientifically the building has regional significance for its potential to reveal information which could contribute to an understanding of hotel operations in the mid-19th century in a major Upper Hunter town and how those operations have changed over the subsequent century.
