STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Historically the building has local significance for having been able to be built between earlier commercial buildings in the main centre of Muswellbrook. It is unusual in this respect and indicates a period in which residential and commercial uses were intermixed. Aesthetically it is representative of type at a regional level. Scientifically the building is of local significance for its potential to reveal information that could contribute to an understanding of the development of the commercial heart of Bridge Street in the early 20th century.
