

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HISTORICAL NOTES <p>Although this form of kerb and guttering was once common in the Hunter Valley (Newcastle and Morpeth also), it is now becoming rare. It enhances the appearance of the older sections of the town. Sections in Lower Brook Street around St. Albans are original. Also original in Sydney and Maitland Streets. The Bridge Street sections are not original.</p>																																			
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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p>The kerbing and guttering is locally significant historically, aesthetically and scientifically. Historically it is identifiable with late 19th century road making in major towns throughout regional (and metropolitan) NSW. Aesthetically it is aligned with a period in which brick and stone were used in complementary fashion in the main street buildings of the towns and in which town design embraced the range of modern day "streetscape" considerations. Scientifically it is significant for its potential to reveal information about available materials and road making practices in late 19th century upper Hunter townships.</p>
