## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Historically private cemeteries of this scale are rare in the region, giving this cemetery regional significance. Socially and scientifically the cemetery has the same status. It provides descendants of the Keys family with tangible evidence of the family's regional importance over a century and a half. In scientific terms it clearly contributes to an understanding of the significant Keys family links and personal details of its members back to the middle of the 19th century.
