

HISTORICAL NOTES

The first record of a burial in the Cemetery dates to 1843. The Cemetery is still used and contains the graves of significant early area pioneers. The Muswellbrook Parish map gives dedication as the Whites/Peter Clarke (who was shot by Bushranger Wilson in 1861) and will thus be significant to the local community in Muswellbrook. Until 1988 the Cemetery contained the unique White family chapel designed by J. Horbury Hunt and was an unusual work for this Architect. The Cemetery also contains many mature trees as well as a section dedicated to War Veterans.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Muswellbrook Cemetery is the major regional Cemetery for the area's early pioneers of note. As such it has regional historic significance for providing records of the families who have settled and developed the area over a century and a half. The Cemetery's regional aesthetic significance is based on the evidence of the early design of the Cemetery and because of its strong links with the eminent White family. Socially the Cemetery is of significance to the descendants of the regions pioneering families, while scientifically, it has regional significance because of its potential to reveal information which could contribute to an understanding of the methods of burial and interpretation of gravesites from the mid 19th century in the major centre of the Upper Hunter.
