

In 1913 the building was extended. The Mural to the Art Gallery was painted in 1988 by the well known artist Brigette Hansen, however, the mural is beginning to show signs of wear and should be repaired by the artist. The Old Rotary Room is located at the rear of the School of Arts building and is thought to have been constructed in 1958. Interestingly the Rotary International sign is still evident above the rear door. The Historical Society also house their maps and other large

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Historically the building is of local significance since it has charted the development of cultural activities in Muswellbrook over the past century. It continues to be used for cultural purposes. Aesthetically the building is a distinctive and rare local example of a type of architecture which celebrated the liberating effects of the new century. Socially the building continues to have strong local significance for providing a centre for the cultural needs of the Muswellbrook community. Scientifically the building is of local significance for its potential to reveal information about the manner of development of cultural activity in Muswellbrook over the past century.
