

ristorically the building has regional significance for its association with the development of the Anglican Church in the Muswellbrook area in the post-railway boom period of the late 19th century and for the scale of influence of the Anglican Church at that time. Aesthetically the building is rare regionally for its type, scale, detail and importance of its Architect. It therefore has regional aesthetic significance. Socially the building has local significance. Scientifically the building has local significance for its potential to reveal information that could contribute to an understanding of the relative importance of the clergy in the life of 19th century major centres and of their lifestyle. It reflects too, the processes of change in such lifestyles over the last century.
