

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

At the time of its construction Giants Creek was at the centre of a relatively populous area of small landholders. It was significant as the only place of worship in the group of buildings forming the Giants Creek township and as such has local historic significance. Its cemetery remains an integral part of this record and contributes to the historic significance of the Church. Aesthetically the building itself is representative of a style not common in the area. As such it has regional aesthetic significance. Socially it is a rare intact survivor of a period when worship was central to the activities of a small community and has local significance. Scientifically the Church and cemetery could reveal information about the lifestyle of a close-knit late 19th century Upper Hunter Valley community. For this they are a rare group and have regional scientific significance.
