

HISTORICAL NOTES <p>Originally Muswellbrook Family Inn in 1843 when Sylvester Thornton was the licensee. It was extended or rebuilt in c.1895. The Hotel-Motel is a two storey brick building with an iron roof and cast iron lacework verandah.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p>Historically this hotel exhibits the changing face of hotels in Muswellbrook perhaps more than its counterparts. It is of local significance for its role in the continuous use of this major site for hotel purposes for a century and a half. It has local social significance for its importance in the recreational life of Muswellbrook's male population over that time. The hotel has local scientific significance for its potential to reveal information about changes in the fortunes and recreational habits of a major upper Hunter Valley town over a hundred years.</p>
