

HISTORICAL NOTES

St Matthias Church of England is the principal church of the Denman parish. This is St Matthias Anglican Church Hall. The Hall was built in 1910 to serve as a Sunday School and to be used for wedding receptions, fetes, etc.. This was typical of this type of building, erected by the larger churches. It is still used by the Church and is currently undergoing renovations.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Historically the Hall is of local significance because it represents the growth phases of the Anglican Church in Denman in the early 20th century. Socially the Hall is also of local significance for its association with the lives of generations of Denman's Anglican community. It is of local significance scientifically for its potential to reveal information which could contribute to an understanding of the scale and types of Church social and educational activity in Denman throughout the 20th century.
