Ogilvie St, Denman level crossing upgrade

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) is upgrading the Ogilvie St level crossing in Denman, to make it safer for road users, pedestrians and rail traffic. The work will include rail works, level & pedestrian crossing upgrade as well as improvements to the road, pedestrian footpath and fencing.

We will be working continuously from **6:00am, Tuesday 21 May to 6:00am, Friday 24 May, including nights**. We will then be working from **6:00am to 5:00pm, Friday 24 May to Friday 28 June**, during the **day only**. To deliver this work, the level crossing at **Ogilvie St, Denman** will be closed during these times.



Why is this crossing being upgraded?

Safety at level crossings is one of our priority areas and we are committed to keeping road users and train drivers safe.

This upgrade will improve both road and rail surfaces, making it safer, smoother and quieter for all users, including vehicles and pedestrians, as well as rail traffic.

Vehicle detour

Vehicles should use the level crossing at Turner St during this time.

Temporary level crossing closure

The Ogilvie St level crossing will be closed to **vehicles and pedestrians** during the following times:

- **6:00am, Tuesday 21 May to 6:00am, Friday 24 May, including nights**

The level crossing will be closed to **vehicles only** from:

- **6:00am Friday 24 May to 5:00pm, Friday 28 June, including nights**
 - Pedestrians will be able to use the crossing during this time.

How could this work affect you?

A vehicle detour will be in operation while we complete these works. Vehicles should detour via Virginia St, Turner St and Almond St (see map on front page). Traffic controllers and signage will guide road users.

You may have noticed we have already begun some construction activities and taking deliveries.

We will provide another update ahead of our August possession, when we will complete the level crossing upgrade.

When completed, bells, lights, boom gates and pedestrian gates will operate at the level crossing.
