## **10.1. Planning and Environment**

#### 10.1.1. Development Application No. 2023-72 - Child Care Centre, 200 Bridge Street Muswellbrook

Council REFUSE DA 2023-72 involving the demolition of four existing dwelling and the construction of a centre based child area facility at 200-206 Bridge Street, Muswellbrook for the following reasons:

- Pursuant to Section 4.15(a)(i) of the Environmental Planning Act 1979 the proposed development would be incompatible with Section 5.10 (4) of the Muswellbrook Local Environmental Plan 2009. The demolition of the existing early 20<sup>th</sup> century dwellings would have an unacceptable impact on the historical significance of the Muswellbrook Business Heritage Area.
- Pursuant to Section 4.15(b) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 the proposed development, as a consequence of the demolition of the early 20<sup>th</sup> century dwellings would have an unacceptable environmental impact by way of adversely impacting the historical and aesthetic values of the Muswellbrook Business Heritage Area.
- Pursuant to Section 4.15(b) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 the proposed development would have a significant adverse environmental impact to adjoining properties as a consequence of the excessive earthworks, retaining walls, and fill balances proposed across the site and the inadequacy of engineering solutions to mitigate these environmental impacts including stormwater management, landscaping and visual intrusion.
- Pursuant to Section 4.15(b) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 the proposed development would have significant adverse environmental impacts with regards to traffic management and safety. The proposed development does not incorporate suitable site access, off-streetcar parking and traffic solutions to manage the safety of vehicles and pedestrians accessing the site in context with the busy New England Highway road environment and the vulnerability of site users.
- Pursuant to Section 4.15(c) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 the following site attributes are viewed to make the subject site is unsuitable for the development proposed:
  - The subject sites location and relationship to the busy New England Highway road environment.
  - The location of the site within the Muswellbrook Business Heritage Area.
