New Year's Eve ("Event")
Conditions of Entry

- This is an unlicensed Event.
- No BYO food, drink or glass permitted within the Event site. Sealed plastic water bottles are permitted.
- Smoking and the use of e-cigarettes (vaping) is prohibited in all areas of the Event.
- If requested, you must present bags for inspection by Muswellbrook Shire Council ("Council"), police or security.
- Council may confiscate any prohibited items or any other items which Council, in its absolute discretion, considers may be used in an illegal, unsafe, antisocial or offensive manner. Confiscated items will not be returned, replaced or reimbursed. Prohibited items include but are not limited to, illicit substances, weapons, drones, dangerous goods, BYO food or drink, bikes, skateboards, scooters.
- Antisocial behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated. You must not use foul and/or abusive language or act in a manner which offends insults, humiliates, intimidates, threatens, disparages or vilifies another person on the basis of that person's race, religion, colour, sexual orientation, descent or national or ethnic origin.
- All political, religious and advocacy parties/groups/individuals or agencies and organisations acting on their behalf whose intent is to raise awareness or spruik the party/group/candidate/individual/cause are not permitted to enter the Event.
- Attendees wearing or displaying inappropriate or unauthorised commercial, political, religious or offensive images, logos etc may be asked to leave the Event.
- Council reserves the right to refuse entry to any person at any time or to remove any person who breaches these conditions of entry.
- Dogs must always be on leash and under effective control of a competent person over the age of 16 years within the Event perimeter.
- For safety and security reasons, you are required to follow all directions and instructions of Council as the Event organisers, security and the police.
- In the event of an emergency, you must follow the instructions of authorised and emergency services personnel.
- No commercial photography, filming or recording is permitted without the prior written consent of Council.
- Council will contract a photographer/s and/or videographer to capture still and moving vision from the Event for future promotional use.
- You acknowledge that you may be photographed, filmed or recorded as a result of your attendance at the Event. You consent to Council using any film, image or recording of you taken at the Event for any purpose, including marketing, promotional or internal purposes, and/or providing these materials to third parties, its commercial partners, media agencies, broadcasters or other media organisations.
- The supply of your personal information by attendance at the Event is voluntary, if you do not wish Council to photograph, film or record you at the Event you may not be able to attend the Event.
- In consideration of being granted entry to the Event you expressly acknowledge and agree that you enter the Event absolutely at your own risk. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Council will not be liable for any direct, indirect, special or consequential loss related in any way to your attendance at the Event.
